## The Lincoln Academy Hosted Their Fourth Annual Scholar Showcase Fundraising Event

A wide variety of curriculum choices are available to TLA scholars, including construction, welding, metal fabrication, painting, fashion design, stained glass, and ceramics. Dozens of original scholar-made pieces from these classes were donated to the silent auction and fundraiser, delighting guests with a colorful way to enjoy the evening's festivities.

TLA Special Projects Manager, Jean Marie McKearn reflects, "We were simply delighted by this year's contributions to the Scholar Showcase. Scholars had been working very hard all year, and this event is a culmination of some of their best work at The Lincoln Academy. It's a wonderful way for us to celebrate their accomplishments. No two pieces were alike!"

For TLA, the annual Showcase event is not just a way to show off the creative accomplishments of scholars - it also helps raise some necessary funds. As a public school, TLA is funded directly by the State of Wisconsin. However, the amount received per scholar is lower than what is received by other public schools in the area. TLA depends on involvement with partnerships and fundraising events like the Scholar Showcase to keep bringing innovative educational opportunities to all scholars.
